1. Today, the matter is listed for PE. PW Sh. V.C. Srivastava has come present for his examination.
2. At this stage, a common application on behalf A-2 and A-3 is moved for admission/denial of documents under Section 294 CrPC for admitting the documents supposed to be proved by LW-124 i.e. Sh. V.C. Srivastava.
3. The repercussions of the said admission have been explained to both the accused persons. They submit that after understanding the implications, they voluntarily intend to admit the said documents. Accordingly, the statement of their counsel Sh. Faraz Maqbool is separately recorded to the effect that he has admitted the said documents on behalf of both the accused persons. The said documents are Ex.P24/A-2/A-3, Ex.P25/A-2/A-3 and Ex.P26/A-2/A-3 (colly).
4. Ld. Counsel for A-1 submits that as the said documents are not related to him, he can neither admit or deny the same.
5. At this stage, Ld. DLA for CBI submits that after admission of the said documents by A-2 and A-3, the said documents are no more required to be

proved as they are related only to the said accused persons. He further submits that LW-124 Sh. V.C. Srivastava was proposed to be examined as a prosecution witness for proving the said documents only and as now, the said documents have been admitted, he is no more required to be examined. Accordingly, his name be deleted/dropped from the list of prosecution witnesses. The said request is allowed and he is discharged unexamined.

6. No other PW is present today.
