JUDGMENT

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 281 of **Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita** , U/Sec 185 of **Motor Vehicle Act ** .
2. The Accused entered appearance. Copies of Prosecution records furnished to the Accused under Section 230 of the BNSS. Particulars of offences read over and explained to the Accused in Malayalam and he understood the same. He desires to plead guilty to the offences alleged and is appraised of its consequences. He voluntarily pleaded guilty to the alleged offences thereafter. Hence, the plea of Accused is accepted and he is found guilty of having committed offences under Sections 281 of the BNS, 185 of MV Act. and is convicted thereof under Section 275 of the BNSS.
3. The benevolent provisions of the Probation of Offenders Act are not invoked in favour of the Convict since this does not appear to be a fit case to invoke the provisions of that Act.
4. As the Convict had pleaded guilty a lenient view is adopted in the manner of imposing sentence.
5. In the result, the Convict is sentenced to undergo imprisonment till rising of the Court for the offence punishable under Section. 281 of the BNS, 185 of MV Act. and to pay a fine of Rs. 500/- for the offence punishable under Section 279 of IPC and in default, to undergo SI for a period of one day.
