

Case took up to the Lok-Adalath held on 09.12.2023. The counsel appearing for accused admits the guilt and hence case called out, Accused absent and counsel for accused present.

The counsel for the accused filed Vakalath and also filed an application under Sec.253(2) of Cr.P.C. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed. The presence of the accused is dispensed with. The counsel for the accused is permitted to plead guilty on behalf of the accused. Consequences of pleading guilty has been explained to the counsel for the accused. Copy of C/s furnished to the accused as required u/s 207 Cr.P.C. Accusation for the offence u/s 92(O) & (R) of K.P Act is read over to the counsel for accused in the language known to him. Since plea of the accused is voluntary, the same is accepted.

ORDER

Acting U/s.252 of Cr.P.C. accused pleads guilty. Hence, the accused is convicted for the offence punishable under Sec.92(O) & (R) of K.P. Act and sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs.50/-**, in default of fine to undergo S.I. for **02** days.
