No report has been received from Aruna Asaf Ali Hospital till date.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that they have submitted the form 'J' to Aruna Asaf Ali Hospital but they were apprised that there is no physiotherapist in the Hospital as of now and in the absence of the same they are unable to assess Locomotor Disability.

Ld. Counsel for Petitioner requests that the directions may be issued to the concerned Medical Superintendent, Hindu Rao Hospital for issuance of disability certificate. She has also filed fresh form 'J'.

Heard. Record perused.

The Petitioner claims that disability occurred owing to the accident.

As per Order No. F No. 24/Misc.Policy/Disability/ DHS/NHS/1039-45 Dated 02/05/2019 issued by the Department of Health & Family Welfare Hindu Rao Hospital is earmarked for Central District for the purposes of assessment of disability. As per observations made by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Company Ltd. Vs Union of India in Writ Petition (s) (Civil) No (s). 534/2020 date of order 16/11/2021, the District Medical Board has been directed to follow the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India *vide* Gazette Notification S.No. 61, dated 05.01.2018 for issuance of disability Certificate.

Accordingly, in terms of the above, the 'Medical Superintendent', **Hindu Rao Hospital**, Delhi is directed to get the petitioner examined by a Medical Board for the purpose of ascertaining neurology/ Orthopedic / permanent disability, if any, and the extent of disability. The petitioner is directed to appear before the office of M.S. Hindu Rao Hospital, Delhi within a week.

The M.S./Medical Board shall be at liberty to fix any other date convenient to them for the medical examination of the petitioner and send the report/disability certificate directly to this Tribunal within 21 days alongwith an attested copy of the records of medical examination carried out for the purpose of assessment of disability. A copy of the same be also provided to the petitioner.

Copy of this order alongwith original 'Form J' bearing photograph of claimant and copy of discharge summary/MLC be sent to the MS concerned.

On request, copy of this order be given *dasti*.

Renotify for consideration of report of disability assessment/ further proceedings on **29.09.2026**.
