

Case called out.

Heard the Counsel for Appellant.

The Appellant/Accused has filed this Appeal challenging the Judgment of conviction dated 19.09.2025 passed by the Civil Judge & JMFC, Ankola in C.C.No.286/2024.

Along with appeal, the Appellant has filed an application under Section 430 of BNSS, seeking suspension of sentence, passed in C.C.No.286/2024.

Perused the application, memo of facts, Judgment of the Trial Court and grounds in the appeal memo.

The Civil Judge & JMFC, Ankola has convicted the Appellant/ Accused in C.C.No.286/2024 dated 19.09.2025 and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1,52,000/- and in default of payment of fine amount, the Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for a period of six month.

The Counsel for Appellant has produced the receipt for having deposited the fine amount of Rs. 2,000/- before the Trial Court.

The Appellant has made out sufficient grounds for suspension of sentence. Hence the following

ORDER

The operation of the sentence of conviction passed by the Civil Judge & JMFC, Ankola in C.C.No.286/2024. Dated 19.09.2025, is hereby stayed for a period of Six months, subject to deposit 20% of the cheque amount within two months from this order, before the Trial Court and to offer bail on personal bond of Rs. 30,000/- with surety for likesum, to the satisfaction of the trial court.
