Case is advanced on application. Sri MS advocate for plaintiffs files IA No.7 U/o 6 Rule 17 R/w Sec 151 of CPC.

Sri NC advocate for Defendant No.1, Sri SV advocate for Defendant No.2 to 4 submits no objections.

Hence, IA No.7 is allowed. Accordingly, proposed amendment is permitted to be incorporated in the plaint as prayed for.

For amendment of plaint and for amended plaint.

Amendment carried out. Sri MS advocate for plaintiffs files amended plaint.

Sri MS advocate for plaintiffs files memo praying to dismiss the suit against Defendant No.5.

Sri NC advocate for Defendant No.1, Sri SV advocate for Defendant No.2 to 4 submits no objections.

Hence, memo is accepted. In view of memo suit against Defendant No.5 is dismissed.

Plaintiff No.1 and 2 and their counsel Sri MS are present.

Defendant No.1 and his counsel Sri NC are present. Defendant No.2 and 4 and their counsel Sri SV are present.

Both counsel files compromise petition

U/o 23 Rule 3 R/w Sec 151 CPC along with notaized copies of Adhaar cards of Plaintiff No.1 and 2 and Defendant No.1 to 4 stating that, both parties have compromised the case as per the terms of compromise petition.

On enquiry, Plaintiff No.1 and 2 and Defendant No.1 to 4 who are present before court voluntarily submits that, they have compromised the case as per the terms of compromise petition. The contents of compromise petition are read over and explained to both parties in the language known to them. Both parties admitted the contents of compromise petition to be true and correct.

The compromise between the parties appears to be voluntary and genuine. Therefore, compromise petition filed by both parties deserve to be allowed.

Hence, I proceed to pass the following:-

ORDER

Compromise petition filed by both parties U/o 23 Rule 3 R/w Sec 151 CPC is hereby allowed.

Accordingly, suit is decreed in terms of compromise petition.

Draw compromise final decree in terms of compromise petition.

Compromise petition shall be part and

parcel of compromise final decree.
