The plaintiff has filed I.A. No.V U/S.151 of CPC praying to direct the commissioner of police, Mangaluru to implement and to enforce the order of injunction passed by this court. It is stated that this the plaintiff has filed I.A. No.2 seeking interim order of injunction and this court has passed an injunction against the defendant. But the defendant is violating the said injunction order and interfering with the personal and professional life of the petitioner. Hence, prayed to direct the commissioner of police to implement and enforce the order of injunction. Heard. Perusal of records disclose that this court has granted temporary injunction against the defendant. It is the contention of the plaintiff that defendant has violated the injunction order. But, plaintiff cannot seek the implementation of injunction order by filing this application U/S.151 of CPC. He has remedy U/O. 39 Rule 2A of CPC. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, implementation of this order U/S.151 of CPC does not arise. Hence, the plaintiff is directed to file proper application. Consequently, I.A. No.V filed under Sec.151 of CPC is hereby dismissed.
