

Case called out.

Heard the Counsel for Appellant.

The Appellant/Accused has filed this Appeal challenging the Judgment of conviction dated 11-11-2025 passed by the Addl. Civil Judge & JMFC., Bhatkal in C.C.No.108/2025.

Along with appeal, the Appellant has filed an application under Section 430 of BNSS, seeking suspension of sentence, passed in C.C.No.108/2025.

Perused the application, memo of facts and Judgment of the Trial court and grounds in the appeal memo.

The Addl. Civil Judge & JMFC., Bhatkal has convicted the Appellant/Accused in C.C.No.108/2025 dated 11-11-2025 and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.94,400/- and in default of payment of fine amount, the Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for a period of six months.

The Appellant has made out sufficient grounds for suspension of sentence. Hence the following;

**ORDER**

The operation of the sentence of conviction passed by the Addl. Civil Judge & JMFC., Bhatkal in C.C.No.108/2025 dated 11-11-2025, is hereby suspended for a period of six months, subject to deposit 20% of the cheque amount within two months from this order, before the Trial Court and to offer bail on personal bond of Rs. 10,000/- with surety for likesum, to the satisfaction of the trial court.

Issue notice to Respondent and call for TCR.
