

ORDERS ON I.A.NO.I

The counsel for the plaintiff has filed I.A.No.I under Order XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 R/W.Sec.151 of C.P.C.

2. Perused the plaint, I.A.No.I and accompanying affidavit and the documents and other materials on record.

3. Considering the materials on record, I am of the opinion that the nature of the properties will have to be protected and notice to the defendants is to be dispensed with in order to avoid delay. In view of the fact that objecting of granting injunction would be defeated by delay. Hence I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The defendants No. 2 and their men, agents, servants or anybody acting on their behalf are hereby restrained by an order of ad-interim exparte temporary injunction from alienating the suit schedule properties shown in the description of suit schedule properties in plaint.

This order shall be in force till further orders.

Issue emergent notice on I.A.No.I through court to the defendant No.2 and suit summons to defendants.

Issue ad-interim exparte temporary injunction if provisions of Order 39 Rule 3(a) of C.P.C. are complied with and issue suit summons to the defendants No.2, if P.F. paid.
