SUBSTANCE OF ACCUSATION(PLEA)

That, you the accused has issued the cheque bearing No. 215809 dated 01.03.2024 for a sum of Rs.4,33,330/- drawn on State Bank of India, Ankola Branch in favour of the complainant towards discharge of legally recoverable debt and when the complainant has presented the said cheque for encashment through Canara Bank, Asnoti Branch, the said cheque has been returned unpaid as per cheque return memo dated 04.03.2024 for the reason **“Funds Insufficient”**. Further inspite of issuance of legal notice dated 01.04.2024 to you by the complainant, you have failed to make payment of the cheque amount within 15 days of receipt of the said notice and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and same is within the cognizance of this Court.
