ISSUES

- 1) Whether the plaintiff proves that suit schedule properties are joint family properties and are in joint possession and cultivation of plaintiff and defendants?
- 2) Whether the defendant No.1 and 12 proves that deceased Narayan Naik had effected a partition on 13-12-1988 in favour of defendant No.12 during his lifetime, as such the property allotted to defendant No.12 is her self acquired property?
- 3) Whether the defendant No.1 proves that Sl.No.1 and 2 of the suit schedule properties are his self acquired properties having been purchased in auction sale for valuable consideration as per order of the

Government, since he has filed an application in his individual capacity?

- 4) Whether the defendant No.1 is entitled for 1/13th share in Sl.No.3 and 4 of the suit schedule properties?
- 5) Whether the defendant No.12 is entitled for 1/13th share in Sl.No.3 of the suit schedule property?
- 6) Whether the defendant No.2 to 4 and 6 are entitled for 1/13th share in suit schedule properties?
- 7) Whether the defendant No.5 and 7 to 11 are entitled for partition and separate possession as sought for in their written statement?
- 8) What order or decree?
