ISSUES

- 1) Whether the plaintiff proves that suit schedule properties are joint family properties of plaintiff and defendant No.1 to 3 ?
- 2) Whether the plaintiff proves that defendant No.1 got executed registered partition deed by playing fraud upon her as contended in para No.7 of the plaint and the same is not binding on her?
- 3) Whether defendant No.1 and 2 proves due execution of registered partition deed dated: 20-01-2020 and further proves that deceased Gange relinquished her right by receiving consideration amount of sum of Rs. 5,000/-?

- 4) Whether the plaintiff proves that the alienation made by defendant No.1 in respect of suit schedule properties without her consent is not binding on her?
- 5) Whether defendant No.1 proves that Sl.No.5 and 6 of suit schedule properties have been alienated with the consent of all coparceners and they have received consideration amount to an extent of their share?
- 6) Whether defendant No.4 and 5 prove that defendant No.1 has alienated Sl.No.5 and 6 of suit schedule properties by virtue of registered sale deed for family necessity?
- 7) Whether the plaintiff is entitled for 1/4th share over suit schedule properties?
- 8) What order or decree?
