

ORDER ON IA No. III

Having heard the arguments of plaintiff's counsel Sri. S.K.N., on IA No.III filed U/o.39 Rule 1 & 2 R/w Sec.151 of CPC, I have

perused the plaint averments and relief sought against the defendants which is one for partition and permanent injunction.

For the reasons stated in the annexed affidavit, the plaintiff has made out prima facie case at this juncture to pass the Exparte Temporary Injunction order without which the very purpose of filing this suit will be defeated. Hence, I proceed to pass the following,

ORDER

Ex-parte Temporary Injunction is granted against defendant No.4 and anybody acting on his behalf restraining them from obstructing to repair the old house and peaceful enjoyment of suit schedule property till disposal of the suit.

Compliance U/o.39 Rule 3(A) of Civil Procedure Code is mandatory.

Issue suit summons to the defendants, order of Temporary Injunction & also notice of IA No.III to the defendant No.4.
