Plea is recorded, read over and explained to L/C Sri MTN for accused No. 1 to 4 and that of learned Counsel Sri MTN has pleaded guilty on behalf of accused No. 1 to 4.

Hence, in view of plead guilty I proceed to pass the following;

**ORDER**

Acting U/sec. 264 of BNSS of 2023 the accused No. 1 to 4 are hereby convicted for the offence punishable U/sec. 87 of K.P. Act.

Accused No. 1 to 4 are sentenced to pay fine amount of Rs.100/-each.

In default of payment of fine amount accused No. 1 to 4 shall undergo simple imprisonment for 15 days.

Hence, in view of plead guilty, I proceed to pass the following;

**ORDER**

Acting U/sec. 264 of BNSS of 2023 the accused No. 5 is hereby convicted for the offence punishable U/sec. 87 of K.P. Act.

Accused No. 5 is sentenced to pay fine amount of Rs.100/-.

In default of payment of fine amount accused No. 5 shall undergo simple imprisonment for 15 days.

Learned Counsel Sri MTN for Accused No.5 is directed to deposit fine amount of Rs.100/-.

The property seized under P.F No.9/2026 dated 23-01-2026, Item No.1 cash of Rs.6020/- is confiscated to State.

Item No. 2, 52 playing cards are being worthless. Hence, they shall be destroyed after the appeal period.

Item No. 3, the amount received by police by conducting auction shall be deposited in the Government concerned head.

Item No.3 and 4, the interim custody of motor cycle No. KA-47-W-7719 and Item No.4, Motor Cycle No.KA-J-9483 are made absolute in favour of its owners.

Hence, the Murdeshwar Police are directed to deposit the P.F amount.

Learned Counsel Sri MTN for Accused No.5 is directed to deposit fine amount of Rs.100/-.

Office is directed to collect the fine amount.  
Hence, matter referred to Lok Adalath.
