ISSUES

1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the suit A, B and C schedule properties are the ancestral joint family properties of themselves and the defendant Nos. 1 to 10?
2. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the gift deed dated 18.09.2010 and the sale deeds executed pertaining to the suit A schedule property in favour of the defendant Nos. 2 and 11 to 17 are not binding on them?
3. Whether the defendant Nos.1, 2 and 13 to 16 prove that the suit A schedule property has been granted in the names of Somayya s/o Era Naik and Durgappa s/o Era Naik in their individual capacity and as such, they became its absolute owners?
4. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for partition and separate possession of their share in the suit A, B and C schedule properties? If so, to what extent?
5. What order or decree ?
