Claim of Rs.4,25,000/-

The petitioner has filed this petition Under Section 166 of
the Motor Vehicle Act claiming compensation of Rs.4,25,000/-

with interest and costs on account of injuries sustained by petitioner Subray Krishna Naik in a motor vehicle accident that occurred on 17-11-2021 at about 4.30 p.m. the petitioner was traveling along with some others in an Lorry bearing Registration No.KA-47/A-2210 from Kuntavani side to towards Bhatkal side along with Hamali work. When the said vehicle reached near Beteveera Temple in Bhatkal Taluk. The driver of the said Lorry who was driving the vehicle very fast and rashly and negligently lost control of the vehicle and dashed to the another Motor Cycle bearing Registration No.KA-47/L-9572. Due to the impact, the petitioner sustained severe injuries.

The petition presented before the Prl. M.A.C.T., Karwar and subsequently transferred to this Tribunal.

AWARD IN TERMS OF COMPROMISE PETITION

That at the request of the parties, the case have been referred to this Lok-Adalat by the Court of the Senior Civil Judge and Member Addl., MACT., Bhatkal on this day for final disposal before us:

In the presence of Sri. G.M. Moger, Advocate for petitioner, Sri. S.M. Bhagwat, Advocate for respondent No.2 and they have filed a memo resolving their disputes by a settlement and we are satisfied that the said settlement is just and fair in the interest of the petitioner and it is ordered and awarded in terms of the compromise memo dated: 14-03-2026. Joint memo is accepted.

It is ordered and awarded that;

The joint memo filed by the petitioner and respondent No.2 is hereby allowed.

It is further ordered and awarded that, the respondent No.2 is directed to pay the compensation amount of Rs.3,00,000/- to the petitioner.

It is further ordered and awarded that, the respondent No.2 is directed to deposit the compensation amount of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh Only) in Tribunal within month from the date of this order.

It is further ordered and awarded that, the respondent No.2 failed to deposit the amount within month, then the respondent

No.2 shall liable to pay the amount with interest at 6% p.a. till realization.

Further, in the event of deposit of compensation amount by the respondent No.2, the petitioner is entitled to get release 80% amount and remaining 20% amount shall be fixed deposited in the name of petitioner in any Nationalized bank for the period of 3 years, subject to withdrawal of periodical interest accrued on F.D.

The joint memo shall form part of the award.
