

## **ORDER ON I.A.No.II**

The Decree-holder/applicant has filed I.A.No.II U/O V Rule 15 R/w section 151 of CPC., seeking relief that notice of JDR No. 1(a) and 4 on behalf of JDR No. 1(g), 5, 1(h), 6 and 1(c). may be served upon the JDR No. 1(a) and 4, who are elder member of the above said JDRs.

It is stated that whenever this Court notice to above said JDRs have intentionally avoiding the service of notice on different grounds, even the decree-holder had taken sufficient steps. Hence, prays to summons of the JDR No. 1(a) and 4 on behalf of JDR No. 1(g), 5, 1(h), 6 and 1(c) may be served on JDR No. 1(a) and 4, who is elder brother of the JDRs.

On perusal of order-sheet, it is noticed that the notice issued by this Court to the JDR No. 1(a) and 4 on behalf of JDR No. 1(g), 5, 1(h), 6 and 1(c) was not served, even sufficient steps taken by the decree-holder. Hence, considering above facts and circumstances, I am of the considered view that summons may be issued to JDR No. 1(a) and 4 on behalf of JDR No. 1(a) and 4 on behalf of JDR No. 1(g), 5, 1(h), 6 and 1(c). Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

### **O R D E R**

The I.A.No.II U/O V Rule 15 R/w section 151 of CPC is hereby allowed.

Issue notice to JDR No. 1(a) and 4 on behalf of JDR No. 1(a) and 4 on behalf of JDR No. 1(g), 5, 1(h), 6 and 1(c), who are elder brothers of the JDR No. 1(g), 5, 1(h), 6 and 1(c). If, P.F. paid.
