Claim of Rs.30,50,000/-

The petitioner has filed this petition Under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicle Act claiming compensation of Rs.30,50,000/- with interest and costs on account of injuries sustained by

petitioner Abdul Khalique S/o. Mohammed Akbar in a motor vehicle accident that occurred on 07-05-2024 at about 1.20 p.m. the petitioner and his son were going towards from their home to Gandhinagar School to vote for Lok Sabha election. That, while the petitioner was being taken by walk on the mud road by his son from Bhatkal side towards Tengingundi to reach Gandhinagar School in a careful manner and when they reached near Gandhinagar Circle, at that time an Electrical Motor Cycle bearing Reg.No.KA-47/EA-0213 belonging to the 1st respondent ridden by Devidas Jatka Naik came from Tengingundi towards Bhatkal side in a highly rash, speed and negligent manner, without following the traffic rules and due to over speed rider of the Motor Cycle lost control over it and dashed to the petitioner. Due to the impact, the petitioner sustained severe injuries.

The petition presented before the Prl. M.A.C.T., Karwar and subsequently transferred to this Tribunal.

AWARD IN TERMS OF COMPROMISE PETITION

That at the request of the parties, the case have been referred to this Lok-Adalat by the Court of the Senior Civil Judge and Member Addl., MACT., Bhatkal on this day for final disposal before us:

In the presence of Sri. A.R. Shaikhji/Shahbaz Ahmed, Advocates for petitioner, Sri. S.M. Bhagwat, Advocate for respondent No.2 and they have filed a memo resolving their disputes by a settlement and we are satisfied that the said settlement is just and fair in the interest of the petitioner and it is ordered and awarded in terms of the compromise memo dated: 14-03-2026. Joint memo is accepted.

It is ordered and awarded that;

The joint memo filed by the petitioner and respondent No.2 is hereby allowed.

It is further ordered and awarded that, the respondent No.2 being the Insurance Company is directed to deposit the compensation amount of Rs.4,60,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Sixty Thousand Only) before this Tribunal within month from today.

In default of defaulting agreed compensation amount within one month, the

respondent No.2 shall liable to pay the compensation amount along with interest at the rate of 6% p.a.

In the event of deposit of compensation amount, the petitioner is entitled to get release 80% amount and remaining 20% amount shall be fixed deposited in the name of petitioner in any Nationalized or Scheduled bank for the period of three years, subject to withdrawal of periodical interest accrued on F.D.

The joint memo shall form part of the award.
