

Accused present and he submits that he intend to plead guilty. Hence, the accusation for the offence U/s. 27(b) of NDPS Act 1985 is read over and explained to the Accused in the language known to him. After knowing the substance of the accusation leveled against him, he submitted that, he is pleading guilty. Since the plea of the Accused is voluntary, I proceed to pass the following.

**ORDER**

Acting U/s. 276(2) of BNSS the Accused is convicted for the offence 27(b)

of NDPS and sentenced to simple imprisonment **till raising of the court** and to pay **fine of Rs. 6,000/-**. In default to pay fine, he shall undergo S.I. for 100 days.

**Accordingly Case is closed.**
