

ORDER ON I.A.No.II

This is an application U/sec.80(2) of CPC praying the court to permit him the plaintiff to dispense with the statutory notice to the defendants No.5 to 8 and to permit him to institute the suit.

I have perused the affidavit annexed to the application and plaint averments also the prayer sought. On perusal, at this stage it appears to the court that there is urgency on the part of the plaintiff to institute a suit without waiting for statutory time of giving mandatory notice to the second defendant. Therefore, the court is of the view that in this stage the plaintiff has made out a case to permit him to institute the suit by dispensing with the statutory notice to be caused to the defendants. Hence, the following:

ORDER

The I.A.No.II filed U/sec.80(2) of CPC filed by the plaintiff is hereby **allowed**. In the result the plaintiff is permitted to institute the suit by dispensing with the statutory notice to the defendants No.5 to 8.
