ORDER ON MAIN PETITION

This petition is filed by petitioner against the respondent under Section 13[3] of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 R/w. Rule 10(3) of Karnataka Registration of Births and Deaths Rules 1999 praying for issuance of direction to the respondent to register the factum of date of birth of petitioner by name Sri. Allabhaksh S/o Abdulrehaman Sarkavas.

2. It is the specific case of petitioner that, he born on 01.06.1978 at Jogankoppa Village, Tq: Haliyal, (U.K), but, his date of birth has not been recorded in the concerned registers maintained by the respondent. Now the petitioner is in need of birth date extract for Govt Facility purpose. When petitioner applied for his Birth Certificate, respondent issued non-availability Certificate in respect of non-registration of date of birth of petitioner by name Sri. Allabhaksh S/o Abdulrehaman Sarkavas in their concerned register. As such, petitioner constrained to file present petition.

3. Notice of the petition is ordered to the respondent. Despite due service, the respondent remained absent, hence, placed exparte.

4. The petitioner has examined himself as PW.1 and produced 03 documents which are marked at Ex.P1 to P3. The respondent has not led evidence on his side.

5. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel appearing for petitioner. Perused the records.

6. Now the following points that arise for the consideration:

1. Whether the prayer made in the application can be granted?

2. What Order?

7. Answers on the above points are as under:

REASONS

8. **POINT NO.1:-** To prove his contention, the petitioner examined himself as PW.1, filed affidavit in lieu of examination in chief reiterating the petition averments and got marked 03 documents as Ex.P1 to P3. PW.1 deposed that, he was born on 01.06.1978 at Jogankoppa Village, Tq: Haliyal, (U.K). On making of an application by the petitioner for issuance of his Birth Certificate, the respondent on 15.11.2025 gave non-availability certificate as per Ex.P1 interalia stating that the factum of birth of petitioner by name Sri. Allabhaksh S/o Abdulrehaman Sarkavas had not been entered in their register. Ex.P-1 apparently shows that the date of birth of petitioner by name Sri. Allabhaksh S/o Abdulrehaman Sarkavas has not been entered in the records maintained at the office of the respondent. Ex.P2 is the Transfer

Certificate of the petitioner issued by the Vice Principal, Government Pre-University College (High School), Haliyal, wherein the date of birth of the petitioner is clearly shown as 01.06.1978. Ex.P3 is the aadhar card of petitioner. Generally, School Certificate is considered as primary evidence to ascertain date of birth of a person. In this case, the petitioner has relied on Transfer Certificate to show his correct date of birth. Hence, the case of the petitioner cannot be disbelieved. The evidence of petitioner and documents produced by him remained unchallenged. Therefore, Court does not find any reasons to disbelieve the testimony and documents produced by PW.1. Therefore, Court is of the considered opinion that, necessary direction requires to be given to enter the date of birth of the petitioner by name Sri. Allabhaksh S/o Abdulrehaman Sarkavas in the concerned register. Accordingly, **this Court answers Point No.1 in the Affirmative.**

9. **POINT NO.2:-** In view of above discussion and for the reasons stated therein, I proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

The petition filed by the petitioner under Section 13(3) of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 R/w. Rule 10(3) of the Karnataka Births and Deaths Rules 1999 is hereby allowed with no order as to costs.

The respondent is hereby directed to enter the factum of date of birth of petitioner by name Sri. Allabhaksh S/o Abdulrehaman Sarkavas was born on 01.06.1978 at Jogankoppa Village, Tq: Haliyal, (U.K) in the concerned register on payment of requisite penalty.
