

Matter is taken before Lok Adalath.

Learned APP is present.

The CW1 and accused No.1 to 3 are present. Learned APP and accused counsel have filed application under Section 359 of BNSS, for compounding the offences Under Sections 329(3), 352, 351(2) R/W 3(5) of BNS. Court has gone through the said application, the contents and consequences of compounding application are explained to CW1 and accused No.1 to 3. CW1 voluntarily agreed to compound offences. Therefore, the application filed by the CW1 and accused No.1 to 3 is voluntary one without there being any force, threat, pressure, undue influence etc.

The alleged offence is compoundable in nature as per Section 359 of BNSS . It is stated in the application that, the CW.1 and accused No.1 to 3 have compounded their disputes amicably and accordingly, the CW1 and accused No.1 to 3 have filed joint application for compounding the offence. The pros and cons of the compounding of the offence has explained to the CW1 and he has agreed to compound the offence. Therefore, the CW1 and accused No.1 to 3 are permitted to compound the offence. Accordingly, joint application filed by the CW1 and accused No.1 to 3 is hereby allowed and consequently, the accused No.1 to 3 are acquitted for the alleged offence.

Bail bonds of accused No.1 to 3 surety if any stand cancelled.

Accordingly, the case is closed.
