ISSUES

1. Whether the plaintiff proves that, during the lifetime of his uncle Sri. Yallappa, the suit schedule properties were joint family properties of himself and his uncle late Sri. Yallappa?
2. Whether the plaintiff proves that, the defendants No.1 and 2 have got created and concocted documents in their favour in respect of suit schedule properties as alleged in the plaint?
3. Whether the defendant No.1 and 2 proves that, they are the bonafide purchasers of suit schedule properties for valuable consideration?
4. Whether the plaintiff proves that, the sale deeds alleged to have been executed by late Sri. Yallappa in favour of defendant No.1 and 2 on 05-09-1984 are not binding on his share?

5. Whether the plaintiff proves that, he is entitled for the relief of declaration to declare that, he is the exclusive owner of suit schedule properties in case, Court holds that alleged sale deeds are illegal documents or otherwise, he is entitled for half share in the suit properties in case, Court comes to the conclusion that, alleged sale deeds are valid documents?
