1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that, they are the only nearest legal heirs of deceased Sri. Kumar S/o Demanna Vaddar, who was expired on 28.05.2023?
2. Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the plaintiff No.1 is the legally wedded wife of late Sri. Kumar S/o Demanna Vaddar and out of their marriage, the plaintiff No.2 has born?
3. Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the defendant No.9 has illegally got entered her name as wife in the Death Certificate of late Sri. Kumar S/o Demanna Vaddar?
4. Whether the plaintiffs prove that, they are entitled for the relief of declaration as sought for?
5. Whether the plaintiffs prove that, they are entitled for the relief of mandatory injunction to direct the defendant No.1 to issue Survival Family Members Certificate?

6. Whether the plaintiffs prove that, they are entitled for the relief of mandatory injunction to direct the defendants No.1 to 8 to delete the name of defendant No.9 as wife in the Death Certificate of late Sri. Kumar S/o Demanna Vaddar and to enter the name of plaintiff No.1 in the same as wife of the deceased person?
7. Whether the plaintiffs prove that, they are entitled for the relief of mandatory injunction to direct the defendants No.6 to 8 to give all death benefits to the plaintiffs as sought for?
8. What order or decree?
