

Order below Exh.1:

This case is arising out of a private complaint filed by the complainant. It is transpired from the record that processes have been ordered to be issued against the accused for the offence punishable under Sections 504, 506(1), 114 of IPC. However, after issuance of processes against the accused, neither the complainant nor his/her learned Advocate has remained present before the Court for prosecuting with the case. As none was remaining present in this case, notice was issued to the complainant for remaining present and prosecuting with the case. The said notice has returned unserved with an endorsement that the complainant is not residing at the place shown in the notice. As this Case is of the year 2005 and nobody remains present before the Court for proceeding with the case and since this Court does not deem it fit, just and expedient to adjourn the case any further, this case is dismissed on account of absence of the complainant under Section 256 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and the accused are hereby ordered to be acquitted of the offence punishable u/s. 504, 506(1) 114 of IPC.

This Order is pronounced in the Special Sitting of Magistrates held on this 26th day of June – 2022 i.e. on the day of National Lok Adalat.
