

Witness appeared and duly sworn on : 27-03-2026

For Further Cross Examination by the counsel for Accused.

Witness entered into the witness box and took oath.

As per my information complainant and my evidence have been preferred. I know the accused since more than 20 years period. Accused availed loan from me as he had financial problem. I gave Rs.5,00,000/- to the accused in the month of January 2025. I have Iron hardware business at Haliyal. I have no other source of income apart of above said business. I am an income tax payee. I gave above said amount in cash. The above said amount of Rs.5,00,000/- has been duly declared by me in concerned ITR document for the year 2024-25, but not produced before this court if required I am ready to produce. With respect to the above said loan transaction there was no written agreement executed among us. When accused demanded loan amount at that time I arranged that amount myself as 1,50,000/- I had with me in cash and rest of amount I received through my credit business and that has been forwarded to the accused. It is not true to suggest that when accused was repairing his house property at that time he approached me and purchased required material on credit base at that time he issued cheque and that

has been miss used by me by filing of present case. After deduction of entire investment and maintenance of my business I use to receive balance profit amount around about 10,00,000/- per year, to that effect I am ready to produce relevant document if required. The disputed cheque was filled up while coming to me by the accused. v It is not true to suggest that the disputed cheque which was issued by the accuse as blank signed cheque and that has been filled up by me conveniently in order to file present case. It is not true to suggest that there was no such loan transaction took place to the accused he never availed any loan from me even though by filing of false case and deposing false evidence against the accused. It is not true to suggest that the amount mentioned under the cheque is not legally recoverable debt.
