

Case taken up before the Lok-
adalath.

Petitioner and his counsel are
present.

Sri. ARN, counsel for petitioner and
Sri. SMB, counsel for respondent No.2
have filed the joint memo agreeing to
settle the claim in full and final settlement
for a sum of Rs.5,50,000/-.

The same is read over to the
petitioner who is present before this lok-
adalath and she has admitted the same to
be true and correct. Compromise arrived
between the parties is lawful and
voluntary.

It is a petition for seeking
compensation due to injuries occurred to
the petitioner in the road traffic accident.

The respondent No.2-Insurance
Company has compromised with the
petitioner by paying the compensation of
Rs.5,50,000/- and petitioner is agreed to
received the same.

Sri. ARN, for petitioner submits the
petitioner has spent more than
Rs.2,00,000/- for her treatment and
requested to release maximum
compensation amount. By considering the
same, joint memo is required to be
allowed and we proceed to pass the
following:

ORDER

Joint memo is accepted.

Petition filed by the petitioner is
allowed in terms of the joint memo.

The respondent No.2-Insurance Company is directed to deposit the compromise amount of Rs.5,50,000/- within 2 months from today.

Failing which the respondent No.2-Insurance Company shall pay the compromise amount with interest @ Rs.6/- percent per annum from today till the date of payment.

Out of the compensation Rs. 1,00,000/- is order to deposited as FD for 3 years in her name in any nationalized bank of her choice.

Remaining amount is ordered to be transferred to her accounts through RTGS/NEFT as per the rules.

Office is directed to draw an award in terms of the joint memo.

Accordingly matter disposed.
