

**ORDER ON IA No.III**

The plaintiff has filed this suit against the defendant for the relief of permanent injunction.

The plaintiff has filed IA No.III U/o 39 Rule1 and 2 R/w 151 of CPC for grant of ad-interim temporary injunction.

Heard plaintiff counsel on IA No.III and perused the plaint averments and affidavit filed in support of IA No.III along with documents produced by the plaintiff. This court has gone through the RTC of suit schedule property produced by the plaintiff. On going through the RTC of Survey No.375A/3. Whereas in Column No.9, Gajanan S/o Narayan Naik, name is entered. This court has gone through the survey map produced by the plaintiff and the other documents on the board.

Considering the nature of the suit and the documents filed along with the plaint, this court is of the opinion that ordering notice to the opponent would delay the proceedings and result in multiplicity of proceedings. Hence, preserving the said property in the same status is necessary, otherwise, the case of the plaintiff would be frustrated, and if notice is ordered, the very purpose of the I.A. will be defeated, and the plaintiff will be put to great hardship. Hence, this court allows I.A No.III and proceeds to pass the following:-

**ORDER**

Issue order of ex-parte temporary injunction, The defendant is restrained from interfering with the peaceful possession of the plaintiff, till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff to comply with Order 39 Rule 3(a) of C.P.C. If compliance is reported, issue emergent notice on I.A. No.III and suit summons to the defendant.
