

ORDER ON U/SEC.144 (1) (a) OF
B.N.S.S

The petitioner has filed this petition U/Sec.144(1) (a) of B.N.S.S seeking maintenance from the respondent. The petitioner has filed application U/Sec.144(1) (a) of B.N.S.S. seeking interim maintenance of Rs.30,000/- per month.

2. It is the contention of the petitioner that, she is legally wedded wife of respondent and their marriage was solemnized on 24.04.2025. After the marriage, the respondent neglected the petitioner. Now the petitioner is residing in her parents' house.

3. Heard the arguments.

4. On the perusal of the documents, it clearly shows that, the petitioner is the legally wedded wife of respondent At this stage, it is not necessary to make enquiry in respect of inflicting harassment alleged by the petitioner. It is the contention of the petitioner that, the respondent is a hotel employee and earning a income of

Rs.80,000/- per month, But, the petitioner has not produced any document to show the income of the respondent. Therefore, at this stage, it is necessary to grant maintenance for the petitioner for her survival. Therefore, this court proceeds to pass the following :-

ORDER

The respondent is hereby directed to pay monthly maintenance of Rs.3,000/- to the petitioner till further order.

Issue notice to respondent.
