

The Plaintiff-applicant has filed this I.A. No. 1 under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 of CPC restraining the Defendant no.6 from alienating, selling or hypothecating or changing his name in village records with regard to suit schedule property till disposal of suit. In the accompanying affidavit to I.A. no. 1 he states that suit schedule properties are joint family properties which are partitioned and this Plaintiffs have share in that properties. Further she had filed a maintenance proceedings against her husband, in between her husband dies on 14.02.2015 and she has given paper publication in Karawali Munjawu dated: 17.06.2014 not to purchase that property since the Plaintiffs have got share in that property, but Defendant no. 6 purchased through Registered Sale Deed. Hence it is binding on them. Hence she has filed this application.

Perused Plaintiff, I.A. No.1 and documents. It appears that the Plaintiffs have also got share in suit schedule properties in order to avoid multiplicity

of proceedings and also to safe guard interest of 2<sup>nd</sup> Plaintiff who is minor. Hence I pass the following order.

**ORDER**

I.A. No. 1 is hereby allowed and the defendant no.6 is restrained from allegating, hypothecating, selling or what so ever in suit schedule properties till further order.
