Case advanced and called out.

Plaintiff and defendant No.1 and 4 are present. D8 to 10 absent.

L/C Sri. RSK signed petition on behalf of D8 to 10.

L/C Sri. VVN files vakalath for D2 to 7 alongwith IA No.I to setaside the exparte against D2 to 7.

L/C Sri. GPH submits that they have no objection to allow the application.

Hence IA No.I is allowed.

L/C Sri. VVN also files GPA copy of D2, 3, 5, 6, 7 given to D4.

Learned counsel for plaintiff and defendants have filed joint compromise petition as required under Order XXIII Rule 3 r/w. Sec.151 of CPC in which it is stated that since the plaintiff has filed the suit against the defendants for the relief of partition in respect to suit schedule properties, now both parties have settled the disputes. Further the counsel for the defendant submits that the amount of Rs. 85,000/- is received by defendant No.2 to 7. Hence prays before this Court to compromise the suit.

I have gone through the contents of the compromise petition. Compromise seems to be lawful. Upon enquiry parties submit that there is no force or coercion upon them rather they have voluntarily entered into compromise. Further, the parties subscribed their signatures to the application and the

order sheet. The parties have submitted copy of their respective Aadhar card to ascertain their identity.

Hence this Court proceeds to pass the following:-

ORDER

The application filed under Order XXIII Rule 3 r/w. Sec. 151 of CPC is hereby allowed.

Draw decree as per compromise petition.
