ORDERS ON I.A. No.I

Counsel for DHR filed I.A. No.I U/s 151 of C.P.C to direct the police to assist the court bailiff to execute the arrest warrant issued against JDRs.

In the accompanying affidavit it is stated that, when court bailiff went to arrest the JDRs, they are interrupted with court bailiff. Therefore court bailiff is not executed the warrant against JDRs. Hence, it is just and necessary to direct the concerned police to assist court bailiff to execute the arrest warrant issued against JDRs.

After perusal of report submitted by court bailiff it reveals that, at the time of execution of arrest warrant against the JDR No.1, he has escaped from the hand of the court bailiff.

The bailiff is unable to execute the arrest warrant which is issued against the JDRs unless assist him by the police. By considering the contents of the application filed by the DHR and report submitted by the bailiff, this court has come to conclusion that, assistance of the police officer to the bailiff to execute the court order is required. Hence, IA No.I filed by the DHR is hereby allowed in the

interest of justice and equity.

PSI of the Concerned Police Station is directed to assist the court bailiff to execute the court order in Ex.P. No118/2020.

Office is hereby directed to intimate the same to concerned Police Station.

Re-issue arrest warrant to the JDRs. No. 1 to 3.
