ORDER

Acting U/sec 252 of Cr.P.C, the Accused is hereby convicted for the offence punishable U/Sec.27(b) of NDPS Act .

The Accused person is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.5,000/- for the offence punishable U/Sec.27(b) of NDPS Act. In default to pay fine, the Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for a period of 5 days.

Total fine of Rs.5,000/-. (Rupees Five thousand only)

In view of payment of fine amount, this case is disposed off.
