

Memo filed by the counsel for the complainant is taken for consideration.

In the memo, it is stated that the accused has paid the amount mentioned in the cheque as per the settlement arrived between the parties and as such, the complainant does not intend to prosecute the present case further and sought for disposal of the same. The counsel for the Complainant Bank has also annexed the letter issued by the complainant Bank where it is stated that the accused has paid the amount and the complainant does not intend to proceed with the present complaint. The letter bears the seal and signature of authorised signatory of the complainant Bank.

Hence, the present complaint is disposed as settled in accordance with the memo.

In lieu of disposal of the complaint, the accused is acquitted for the offence punishable u/Sec.138 of N.I.Act.
