Issues

- 1 Whether the plaintiffs prove that the plaint schedule properties are the Hindu undivided ancestral joint family properties of themselves and the defendant No.1?
- 2 Whether the defendant Nos.2, 6 and 9 prove that by executing general power of attorney deeds, the plaintiffs, defendant No.1 and their mother and the deceased Sharada Vishweshwar Bhat Gopi had authorized defendant No.2 to sell the properties as stated in the written statement of defendant No.2?
- 3 Whether the plaintiffs prove that the sale deeds executed by the defendant Nos.2 and 9 in favour of defendant Nos.3 to 8 and 10 as stated in the plaint are null and void and not binding on them?
- 4 Whether the plaintiffs prove that Will dated 23-12-2016 alleged to have been executed by the deceased Sharada Vishweshwar Bhat Gopi is illegal, null and void and not binding on them?
- 5 Whether the suit of the plaintiffs is bad for non joinder of necessary parties?

- 6 Whether the suit of the plaintiffs is barred by time?
- 7 Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for 1/4th each share in the plaint schedule properties?
- 8 Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the reliefs sought in the plaint?
- 9 What order or decree?
