defendant no. 5 (a) to (d) .

The L/c for plaintiff is directed to amend
the cause title and to file amended plaint.

Advocate for plaintiff has amended the
cause title and he has filed amended plaint.

The plaintiffs and defendants have
filed joint compromise petition U/O 23
rule 3 of CPC and prays to decree the
suit as per the terms in the compromise
petition.

Heard arguments of both sides.

:: ORDERS ON COMPROMISE PETITION

::

The Plaintiffs and defendants have
jointly filed compromise petition U/o 23
Rule 3 of CPC. The contents of the
entire compromise petition read over
and explained to the Plaintiffs and
defendants and the said contents are
admitted as true and correct by the
Plaintiffs and defendants.

Perused the records, and in the
compromise petition it is stated that,
they have compromised and it is further
mentioned that, the Plaintiff no. 1 to 4
and defendant no.1 to 4 have taken

their respective share over the suit schedule properties. The Defendant no. 5(a) to (d) and D-6 are not claiming any thing and they have relinquished their right to the plaintiffs and Defendant no. 1 to 4.

This court orally enquired with the Plaintiffs and defendants and they submitted that they have agreed the same in terms of conditions as mentioned in the compromise petition.

Both the parties have filed their respective Adhar Cards for the purpose of their identity in compliance of circular issued by the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka. The Adhar cards of the both the parties verified by this court.

The Plaintiffs and defendants have agreed to compromise in terms of the compromise petition. That, on perusal of the entire terms and conditions of compromise petition and case records it appears that the compromise between parties to the suit are lawful and there is no force, coercion and misrepresentation and in accordance with law. Hence the said compromise petition is deserves to be accepted and compromise is recorded, in the result , this court proceed to pass the following : -

The Compromise petition filed by the both parties U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC is hereby accepted.

The suit is decreed in terms of the said compromise petition.
