Case called out.

Complainant by name Sri. Rajesh S/o Ramachandra Naik is present, APP present.

Accused No 1 and 2 present. Advocate for Accused absent.

Perused records, the alleged offences in the present case are triable by this court and compoundable in nature.

As per the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Suomoto Writ Petition No.4/2021 this case is taken up for plea bargaining.

The advantages of compounding/plea bargaining of the offences are explained to complainant and he submitted that he is ready for settlement.

Conciliation held.

The complainant and accused have jointly filed application U/Sec.359 of BNSS seeking permission to compound the matter.

The accused is herein paid Rs.7000/- (Rupees Seven Thousand only) to the state as damages and the PDO has issued the receipt in this regard.

The offence is P/U/S 303(2) of BNS. The complainant herein has compounded the matter.

In view of the application submitted by the complainant and accused, they are permitted to compound the offence punishable under Section 303(2) of BNS.

Accordingly the application filed under Section 359 of BNSS is hereby accepted.

Accordingly the matter is compromised.

In view of the above order this case is disposed of.
