None appeared on behalf of revisionist or respondent despite the fact that the case was called several times since morning. Case file perused. The present revision has been filed by the revisionist against the respondent against order dated 12.07.2022, passed by the learned Trial Court vide which conditional warrants were issued against the revisionist for the payment of interim maintenance. The perusal of main file reveals that the revisionist has been proceeded against ex parte in the main file and has not paid the amount of interim maintenance to the respondent. In these circumstances, it cannot be said that the order dated 12.07.2022 issuing conditional warrants against the revisionist is illegal, unreasonable or irregular. Since, the revisionist has not paid the amount of interim maintenance to the respondent, the procedure adopted by the learned Trial Court to recover the amount from revisionist by issuing conditional warrants against him is proper and legal. As such, the revision filed by the revisionist is without any merit and the same is therefore, dismissed. Copy of order along with trial Court record be returned. Revision file be consigned to records, after due compliance.
