

ORDER ON INTERIM APPLICATION

Petitioner has sought for interim maintenance of Rs. 25,000/- per month from the respondent.

2. Petitioner states that she married to respondent on 27.01.2016 according to Muslim rituals and was living with him. She alleges that respondent and his sisters started assaulting the petitioner in demand of dowry of 10 tolas gold. She was sent to her parent's house to bring dowry but the petitioner informed at Jamayath on 28.04.2016. There was a meeting on 31.05.2016 and respondent was advised by the elders. But even after that respondent kept the petitioner in a separate house and tortured her physically and mentally in demand of dowry by saying that if you don't get money he will get remarry. She was again send to her parent's house in demand of dowry and on 04.06.2016 there was a panchayath at jamath on 29.06.2016 in Noorani Masjid. On that day respondent gave triple talaq to the petitioner forcibly. It was ordered by the jamath that petitioner shall be given Rs.2,81,500/- from the respondent but till date it is not give any money. It is stated that the respondent is a diploma holder in electrical and he works as house contractor and he earns Rs.50,000/- per month. Hence, she is requesting to award interim maintenance of Rs. 15,000/- to petitioner per month as interim maintenance till disposal of the petition.

3. Petitioner has produced marriage certificate, FIR and Noorani Masjid letter documents. Petitioner has made out prima facie case that the respondent has not taken care of her. Though it is too early to decide the claim of the petitioner, to prevent vagrancy and to protect petitioner -a woman, it is necessary to grant interim maintenance of Rs.3000/- per month

until further orders. With this view, I pass the following:

ORDER

The respondent is hereby directed to pay a sum of Rs.3,000/- per month to petitioner from the date of petition till further orders.

Issue notice, notice on I.A.No.I and exparte interim order to respondent through RPAD if PF paid.

Returnable by 02.08.2019.
