Chief examination by: Public Prosecutor.

1) Since 5 years, I am working as Medical Officer at Primary Health Centre, Padubidri.

2) On 25-02-2022 at 10:15 a.m., C.W.1 Susheela approached O.P.D., with a history of assault on 25-02-2022 around 8.00 a.m. Patient was found tachypneic, tachycardia and very anxious. No external wound noted. Patient complaints of severe myalgia, tenderness over the body.

3) I am of the opinion that, severe myalgia due to trauma and assault. Referred to District Hospital, Udupi, for further evaluation. Accordingly, I issued wound certificate. Now I see said Wound certificate and it bears my signature and same is marked as **Ex.P-16** and signature of the witness is marked as **Ex.P-16(a)**. The

MLC records relating to Ex.P.16 were maintained in our hospital. True copies are supplied to I.O. Now I see the same and marked at Ex.P.17. The nature of injuries are mentioned in Ex.P.16 and 17 are simple in nature.

4) The Injuries mentioned in Ex.P.16 and 17 will be caused by assault or by manhandling.

Cross examination by: Sri. T.V.K.S Advocate for Accused.

1) In both Ex.P.16 and 17 does not disclose the name of assailant. The features noted with the patient may be suffered even by the patient approaching the hospital by running. At the time of examination, I did not notice in marks of assault on the body of the injured as she was examined at 10.15 a.m. Initially we attended in our hospital with proper first aid including drips. However patient was still feeling anxiety. Hence, I referred for further evaluation. There are many reasons to suffer a anxiety. There may be anxiety even when telling a lie.
