Chief examination by: Public Prosecutor

1) Since last 15 years, I am working as Pathologist at District Government Hospital, Udupi.

2) On 15-05-2022, at 3:00 a.m., I examined one CW.1, Sandesh, aged about 22 years, with a history of assault by 8 people Harsha, Sukesha etc., at 1.30 a.m. on 15-05-2022 at Padematta.

3) On examination of the patient, I found following injuries;

- 1) Left eye tenderness and swelling seen left orbital fracture
- 2) Abrasion on the upper aspect of the back.

4) I am of the opinion that the injuries are fresh in nature. Injury No.1 is grievous and injury No.2 is simple in nature. Accordingly, I issued wound certificate. Now I see said Wound certificate and it bears my signature and same is marked as **Ex. P-4** and signature of the witness is marked as **Ex.P- 4(a)**.

5) Injury No.1 may be caused by the assault of fist. The Injury No.2 may be caused by pushing and dragging of the injured on ground. The injured was discharge on 17-05-2022 after the treatment by the Eye Specialist. The Case sheet, Scan report,

Discharge summary are produced and same are marked as Ex.P5 to Ex.P7.

Cross examination by: Sri.S.S.N. Advocate for Accused.

1) It is false to say that, I being a specialist cannot attend causality duty. There are eye specialists in hospital. I collected the history about the injury of injured. Injury No.1 mentioned in the Ex.P4 may be caused by the direct contact with any blunt and hard object. The injured while attending the work and falling on the hard surface may sustain the injury found in Ex.P4. It is false to say that, the injured did not suffered the injury found in Ex.P4. It is false to say that Ex.P 4 is issued to police to file a false case on accused.
