Today the case was fixed for filing written-statement on behalf of defendants no. 7 and 8 as well as for consideration on application seeking setting aside of exparte order.

A perusal of the case file reveals that defendants no. 7 and 8 have not filed their written statement since 26.04.2024. They have availed four effective opportunities and a period of more than 10 months. No reasons have been provided for non filing of their written statement within the statutory period. No ground for further adjournment is made out. Therefore, the defence of defendants No. 7 and 8 is hereby struck off. Now, the case is adjourned for consideration on application seeking setting-aside of exparte order against defendant no. 6. Both the parties are notified that it shall be the last opportunity for arguments. Now, the case is adjourned to 20.05.2025.
