1) It is false to say that, the tenderness is recorded only on the say of the injured. But, we observed the expressions, both visible and audible. While examining the injured, including limbs or parts of the body for complained assault or impact. When only tenderness are observed normally there may or may not be any injuries. It is incorrect to suggest that, an injured may mislead the examination for tenderness. The injuries noticed in Ex.P.16 may be sustained by accidentally falling on the rough surface. Based on the colour of the injuries, duration of the injuries to the time of the examination is approximately ascertained. There cannot be a definite time gap assessment of injuries in terms of hours. It is false to say that, Ex.P.16 is issued without proper examination of the injured.
