

Orders on Bail application

Learned Counsel for accused filed the bail application under Sec.478 of B.N.S.S. and requested to enlarge the accused on bail in the case for the alleged offenses punishable under Sec.146, 196 of IMV Act and Sec.281, 106(1) of BNS. The offences are bailable in nature and accused is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in the case. The accused is law – abiding citizen having deep roots in the society. Accused is ready and willing to abide the conditions imposed by this court. Hence, prayed to allow the application.

On perusal of the case papers, it can be seen that, so offenses are bailable in nature. The investigation in this case is completed, so therefore accused is not required for investigation. As on this day, prosecution is not moved any application for further investigation. So therefore, the court proceed to pass the following :

ORDER

Bail application filed under Sec.478 of BNSS by the learned counsel for the Accused is hereby allowed. Accused is enlarged on bail subject to the following conditions.

1. Accused is directed to execute the bond for the amount of Rs.50,000/- along with one surety for like sum.

2. Accused is directed to appear before the court in all the dates of hearing.

3. Accused is directed not to commit any offense and not to destroy the evidence of prosecution.
