Heard. Record perused. The Record reveals that the accused is on trial for possession of 80 capsules of Spasmo Proxyvon Plus (each capsule weighing total 385 mg and containing tramadol HCL weighing 50 mg) and therefore, as per **Hira Singh v. Union of India (2020) 20 SCC 272**, the quantity of the contraband comes to be $80 \times 385 \text{ mg} = 30,800 \text{ mg}$ or **30.8 grams** which is intermediate quantity.

As such, this case ought to have been committed to the Court of Ld. Special Judge-I, Kangra at Dharamshala for trial.

The trial in the case has already begun and as many as 9 witnesses have already been examined. As such, resorting to Section 323 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, I hereby commit the present case to the Court of Ld. Special Judge-I, Kangra at Dharamshala.

The concerned Ahlmad is directed to send the records of the case and the documents and articles, if any, which are to be produced in evidence and notify the public prosecutor of the commitment of the case to the Ld. Special Judge-I, Kangra at Dharamshala.

Parties are directed to appear before the Ld. Special Judge-I, Kangra at Dharamshala on **07.08.2026**. Records be sent well in advance. With this, the present challan is disposed off.
