

ORDERS ON I.A.

The plaintiff has filed the I.A. under Order V Rule 20 and Sec.151 of C.P.C. and requested to issue notice in 'Udayavani' Kannada Daily Newspaper.

Further in the memorandum of facts it is deposed that, the summons issued to defendant No.6 to 9 and 13 in the case by registered post has not been served and they are keeping out of way for the purpose of avoiding the service of summons and suit summons to the defendant No.6 to 9 and 13 cannot be served in the ordinary way. Hence prays to issue service of suit summons to the defendant No.6 to 9 and 13 by substituted service of paper publication.

So therefore, it is quite evident from the perusal of order sheet that, plaintiff has made best efforts to serve the summons in the normal course as well as by way of RPAD. So, therefore, this court proceeds to pass the following:
