Report on application for releasing vehicle bearing registration No. **HR-30S-6156** on superdari received. Police report perused. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Sunderbhai Ambalal v. State of Gujarat AIR 2003 SC 638*, has held that power under section 451 Cr.P.C. (497 (1) BNSS) should be exercised expeditiously and judicially and also held that Magistrates should take immediate action for seeing that powers under section 451 Cr.P.C. (497 (1) BNSS) are properly and promptly exercised and articles are not kept for a long time at the police station, in any case for not more than fifteen days to one month.

Vehicle mentioned in the police report is hereby ordered to be released to the applicant/owner Gourav Singh to the satisfaction of SHO concerned subject to furnishing superdari bonds to the tune of ₹ 2,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to usual terms and conditions including that the superdar shall not sell, shall not change its colour and shall produce the same in the court as and when required. Before releasing the said vehicle to the applicant, the photographs of the same be taken and attached with the challan so that the same be treated as proof of case property. Superdari bonds and surety bonds be also attached with challan. The concerned SHO before releasing the aforesaid vehicle, shall prepare a Panchnama and verify the factum of ownership *qua* the aforesaid vehicle.

Copy of this order be sent to the SHO concerned for compliance.
Application is disposed of and papers be tagged with challan/FIR.
