

ORDERS ON I.A.NO.X

Counsel for plaintiff filed I.A.No.X under Order XXXII Rule 14-A and Section 151 of CPC and requested to discharge the guardian of defendant no.7 by declaring that defendant no.7 is attained majority. In the affidavit plaintiff stated that, defendant no.7 is attained majority as per Ex.D2. The plaintiff requested to discharge the guardian defendant no.7.

2. According to plaintiff defendant no.7 is attained majority as per Ex.D2. On perusal of Ex.D2 Aadhar card of defendant no.7 namely Sulaksha, the date of birth was mentioned as 20.06.2005. When take the date of birth noted in Ex.D2 it clears that defendant no.7 is attained majority. The defendant no.7 is getting legal right to take decision on her own. Such being the case, it is necessary to discharge the guardian of defendant no.7. Hence proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

I.A.No.X filed by the plaintiff under Order XXXII Rule 14(a) of C.P.C. is hereby allowed.

Hereby discharge the guardian of defendant no.7 by declaring she attained majority.

To note the same in the plaint formal amendment is required.

Plaintiffs are directed to carry out
