Petition filed under Sec. 166 of M. V. Act, 1988, by the petitioner to claim a sum of Rs.7,38,000/- being the compensation by the petitioner for the Death caused in a motor vehicle accident alleged to have been caused due to the rash and negligent driving of the motor cycle bearing Regd. No. KA-20-EC-8768 on 19-04-2025 at about 21.10 hrs, at Udupi-Kinnimulki Road, Near Govindra Kalyana Mantapa, Jodukatte, 76th Badagabettu Vilage,Udupi.

This petition coming on 25-07-2026 for final disposal before me in the presence of Smt.P.K.,Advocate for petitioner and of Sri.A.R.K., Advocate for R1 and Sri. M.R., Advocate for R2 and the matter stood over for consideration till this day, this court doth hereby order and award as follows:

1. That, the claim petition filed under Section 166 of Motor Vehicle Act, by petitioner against respondent is hereby allowed in part with cost.
2. That, the petitioner is entitled for total compensation of **Rs. 2,17,563/- (Rupees two lakhs seventeen thousand five hundred and sixty three only)** with interest at the rate of

6% p.a., from the date of petition till date of realization.

3. That, the respondent 1 and 2 are jointly and severally liable to pay compensation and respondent No.2 is directed to deposit the compensation within 60 days from the date of this order.
4. That, upon deposit of the compensation amount the petitioner is entitled to receive the entire amount.
5. That, office is hereby directed to transfer entire amount to the petitioner after obtaining copy of the pass book, copy of Aadhar card and PAN card if any.
6. That, the respondents shall pay to the petitioner the sum of Rs.1,134=00 towards the cost of the petition.
