ORDER ON BAIL APPLICATION FILED BY
THE ACCUSED - SADANANDA UNDER
SECTION 480 OF THE B.N.S.S.2023

Sri. B.M.S., advocate for accused has filed the instant application, along with anticipatory bail in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 163/2025 on the file of II Additional District and Sessions Judge, Udupi, and sought for his enlargement on bail .

In view of anticipatory bail in Crl.Mis.163/2025 objection from learned A.P.P., has not been called for.

Heard from the counsel for accused .

The following point arise for determination.

“Whether the accused is entitled for bail as prayed for?”

My answer to the above said point is in ‘affirmative’, for the following:-

REASONS

The offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 115(2), 351(2), 352, 74 OF BNSS 2023. It is the allegation of accused is that he has not committed any alleged offences , that the alleged offences are not punishable with death or imprisonment for life, which are triable by this court. That he is the permanent resident of Renjala Village, along with his family and that he is not involved in any crime. That he is ready and willing to abide by the conditions imposed by this court.

Though the alleged offences are non-bailable, are neither punishable with death or imprisonment for life. Accused persons are already privileged to get the bail as per order in Crl.Mis. 163/2025. Further the alleged offences are

exclusively triable by this court . Thus if the accused are enlarged on bail by imposing stringent conditions, no hardship will be caused. Hence the above point is answered in '**Affirmative**' and pass the following:

ORDER

The application filed by the accused U/Sec. 480 of B.N.S.S., 2023 is here with allowed.

The accused - Sadananda is enlarged on bail in C.C.No. 231-2025 (Crime No. 17/2025 of Ajekar Police Station) subject to the following conditions:

1. Accused shall execute personal bond for Rs.25,000/- each (twenty five Thousand) with one surety for the like sum;
2. He shall appear before the court as and when required;
3. He shall not tamper the prosecution evidence and witnesses;
4. He shall not indulge in any criminal activities hereinafter.
